

# CREATE A SUN VISOR



You Will Need:

- paper plate
- markers, pencil crayons, crayons or paint
- stickers, glitter, sequins, washi tape—whatever you want to use to decorate your visor
- hole punch
- elastic (available at dollar stores and fabric stores)
- pony beads
- ribbons (optional)

Instructions:

1. Cut a paper plate into a half moon shape.
2. Use markers, crayons, glitter glue, stickers and washi tape to decorate the bottom of the plate. Make it fun and colorful!
3. Use a hole punch to punch a hole at each point of the half moon shape.
4. Thread a piece of elastic through the holes. The ends of the elastic should stick out on the top side of the visor.
5. Slide a bead on to each end of the elastic. Adjust the beads to change the size of the visor until it's the right size for your head.
6. Tie a knot in each end of the elastic.  
Make your visor extra bright and colorful by tying ribbons to the elastic.
8. Voila! You're done! Put the paper plate sun visor on your head and enjoy the summer sunshine!
